


This Outcomes Framework lays out the short, medium and long-term outcomes associated with the indicators identified for the Early Years Framework. The Outcomes Framework follows the life course of the child from pre-birth (pregnancy) to age 8. The short-term outcomes sit on the left hand side of the page, moving across to the longer-term outcomes on the left hand side. The most long term outcomes are those associated with the National Outcomes and the over-arching SHANARRI Principles of Getting It Right for Every Child (GIRFEC). 




